### **Two Safety Milestones Reached At Bekaert**

The window film manufacturer has had no recordable injuries or lost time accidents for 365 days at its San Diego, CA facility.

Bekaert Specialty Films employs approximately 200 individuals at the site. Bekaert, a global leader in the development, manufacture and distribution of solar and safety window film products, was proud to mark one year without a lost time accident or an Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) recordable injury in the manufacturing areas.

"We are constantly striving to improve our manufacturing practices, whether through our 5S manufacturing philosophy, or through our company-wide focus on and commitment to health and safety," said Christophe Fremont, president of Bekaert. "We firmly believe that this focus on excellence makes us a more responsible company, a better business partner, and enables us to develop world-class products unmatched in the window film industry."

The safety milestones reached last month are a result of Bekaert's "Because Employees are Responsible (BEAR)" program, launched in November 2005. The BEAR program is a behavior-based plan that has as its ultimate goal the elimination of on-the-job accidents and encourages employees to take personal accountability for their actions and their work areas in regards to safety.
